The borough council of Mifflintown met this date in the municipal building at 100 Cross Street, Mifflintown PA. The meeting was called to order by Vice President Richard Zimmerman Jr at 7:30p. President Samuel Klinger was absent. The following were in attendance Richard Zimmerman Jr, Mark Turns Jr, Brian Baker, Karen Haas, Robin Saner, Sec/Treas, Mark Aurand, Maintenance. Zina Klinger was absent. Gabriel Hetrick, new chief of PREMS and Jared Hetrick, new Station Commander at the Lewistown Barracks of the State Police were guests at the meeting. Hetrick was talking about his position and what he wants to accomplish with PREMS. Commander Hartsock wanted to first thank the council for the Bridge Dedication ceremony. He said the program was excellent and it was the sincerest, personable event he's attended for Trooper Rougeau! He also commented that DA Snook did an outstanding job with his speech. And secondly, he went over several statistics for the last year including crimes against society, crimes against a person, motor vehicle crashes, and several others.


Saner reported for Zina Klinger who was out. Meter money collected was \$813.29 and ticket money was \$565 for a total of \$1378.29 for the month. Klinger wrote out 40 tickets. Mark Aurand, maintenance was up next. He's been cleaning drains and picking up trees and limbs from the storm damage. He sprayed weeds for the 3rd time this season. Mulching is done. The camera is fixed at the park and the mower is fixed. Probation is painting the porch at the park. Some of the crosswalks still need painted. Mark suggested we start to trim trees at the playground, like 3 a year? He will check with Penn State Extension Office to see if they know who to call? Basketball hoop netting is still not here. Saner to get a hold of the company where they were ordered. Also Saner needs to check with Cleck's about when they plan on painting the lines at the basketball court? Mark is on vacation July 13-20.


The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved. Motion was first made by Baker, 2nd by Haas to approve them. Next the treasurer's report was approved. Motion made by Baker 1st and 2nd by Turns Jr. Saner went over correspondence from the mayor since she was absent. Mayor McGinnis wanted to thank the council for all their support with the Bridge Dedication. She also wanted them to know if they didn't already that she was the president of the group, "Supporting Our Heroes of Central PA". McGinnis performed a wedding and received \$100. And she has two more coming up on July 22 & 23. She also asked Mark to get the playground ready like he did last year for National Night Out on Tues. Aug. 6.

The exoneration of an applicant in the borough was approved. Motion first by Haas, 2nd by Baker. It was brought up about golf carts being allowed to run in the borough. Currently there are no codes or ordinances addressing this. The council wants to table the subject to another time. There was a motion to approve paying the monthly bills; first by Baker, second by Turns Jr.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30p on a motion made first by Baker and second by Haas.
