

Mifflintown Borough
October 7, 2024

The borough council of Mifflintown met on this date in the municipal building at 100 Cross Street, Mifflintown PA. The meeting was called to order by Vice President Richard Zimmerman Jr. at 7:00p. President Samuel Klinger and Mayor McGinnis were absent. The following were in attendance: Richard Zimmerman Jr. Karen Haas, Mark Turns Jr, Brian Baker, Robin Saner, Sec/Treasurer, Zina Klinger, Meters and Mark Aurand, Maintenance.

Zina collected \$1033.32 from the meters and \$775.00 from fines for a total of \$1808.32. And she wrote 54 tickets. Mark told council Cleck's still had to put down the handicap mats and top soil but then would be finished with the project. Payment would be made at the time everything was completed. We are still waiting on Hawbaker's to finish the paving on Cross Street. Mark has the BBQ pit ready for the Lion's chicken barbeque on Wed. Oct 16th. He cold patched at Karen's curb, and Tim Beasom's and Tammy Smith's; he fixed one of the meters; painted parking spaces at the courthouse; fixed the road to the river; changed the oil in the leaf blower; had 2 tires put on the truck; cleaned the mini splits in the borough building, etc. He also along with Roxann talked to the homeless gentleman living under the walking bridge and they put him in touch with an outreach program. Mark and Baker and McGinnis met and went over new signage at the playground. Three signs need replaced. Mark received a quote from Swart for \$700 for all three. Council voted to have them made 1st with a motion by Baker and 2nd by Haas. He received a quote from Goshorn's Electric to replace the 28 receptacles on the poles for the Christmas lights. Quote is \$11,830.00. Council agreed to pull the money from the Pligit account. Turns made the motion followed by Haas to check into taking the money from the account. Saner will check if any penalties for taking the money out.

The minutes from the September meeting were approved on a motion made 1st by Baker and 2nd by Turns. The Treasurer's Report was also approved. Motion 1st made by Haas and 2nd by Baker.

Saner researched the cost of renewing the desktop version of QuickBooks or changing over to the online version. The online version would be \$1783.80 versus renewing the desktop version at \$1537.60. The council voted to renew the desktop version and then possibly making the switch to the online version next year sometime. The insurance renewal is due. Total for that is \$13,0703.00.

Vice president Zimmerman gave the mayor's report. She did one wedding and received \$20.00. She wants to remind everyone of the New Year Eve's celebration this year. There was not any new business to report. Saner informed council of her upcoming surgery on November 19th which is a Tuesday and she's hoping to be back to work the following week.

Council approved for the bills to be paid. 1st motion made Baker and 2nd by Turns.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00p on a motion made 1st by Turns and 2nd by Baker.
