

Mifflintown Borough
February 2, 2026

The borough council met on this date at the municipal building at 100 Cross Street, Mifflintown. The meeting was called to order by President Samuel Klinger at 7:00p. The following were in attendance: Mayor Roxann McGinnis, Richard Zimmerman Jr, Karen Haas, Brian Baker, Mark Turns Jr, Zina Klinger, meters: and Jason Aitkins Jr, maintenance.

At 7:01p Solicitor Randy Zimmerman called for an Executive Session. The session lasted until 7:40p. Approval to return to main meeting was approved 1st by Zimmerman Jr and 2nd by Haas. Council then voted to designate Mayor McGinnis to act as the borough designee and along with Zimmerman meet with Wendy at CCD. Motion was approved by Klinger 1st and Baker 2nd. Also, council agreed and approved for Zimmerman to send a letter to CCD. That motion was 1st by Klinger and 2nd by Baker. Solicitor Zimmerman also announced to council his new rate per hour is \$150 compared to the \$125 before.

We heard from Aitkins Jr, maintenance manager and he informed the council that in January he fixed the snowblower; fixed the radiator and tire on the truck; and handed out warnings to home owners who hadn't shoveled within the 24-hour time frame according the ordinance. He spent many hours cindering and plowing!!

Meters, Zina Klinger wrote out 42 tickets in January totaling \$550 and collected \$957.78 from the meters. Grand total was \$1487.78 Minutes from the previous meeting were approved 1st by Zimmerman Jr and 2nd by Turns Jr. The treasurer's report was also approved with a motion from Zimmerman Jr 1st and Klinger 2nd.

Saner mentioned the Emerging Leaders are inviting council to an unveiling of the bench and historic marker downtown on Thurs. April 16th at 1:00p. Mayor McGinnis wanted to thank everyone for the snow clean-up in the borough: Aitkins Jr., Paul Shellenberger, Sam, Zina, Zimmerman's Excavation, Chris and Derek Casner. A job well done! The mayor also has National Night Out scheduled for Tuesday, August 4th.

In Unfinished Business council discussed purchasing new Christmas lights. Haas is looking into the purchase with direction from council as to what to buy, how many to buy, and cost. She is to report back at the March meeting. Item 2, Front Street bridge is tabled until Aitkins Jr gets a price for the repair.

The council members recognized April as "Safe Digging Month" with a motion made by Baker 1st and Turns Jr 2nd. CCD issues and Airbnb's were tabled to talk about next month. There was one exoneration council voted on. It was approved by Zimmerman, Jr 1st and Klinger 2nd. Saner had an application for a new Deputy Tax Collector, Paul Kristula. Council voted and approved him with a motion 1st by Zimmerman Jr and 2nd by Klinger.

The bills to be paid in February were approved 1st by Baker and 2nd by Haas.

Adjournment was at 8:15p. Zimmerman Jr made the motion 1st followed by Baker 2nd.
